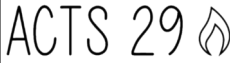

Len Buttner will be speaking about personal and spiritual revival, marriage, finances and ministry. More information in the pamphlets in the church foyer.

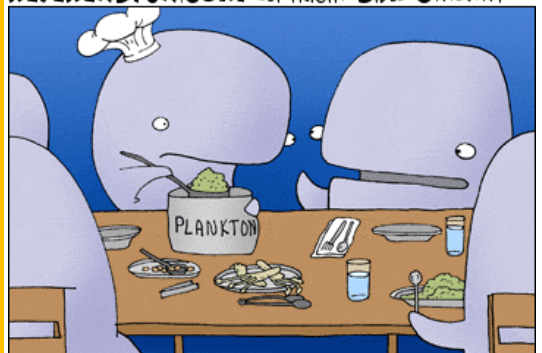
Kitchen
